**Gumbo Competition will have three winners: 1. Judges Choice 2. People's Choice 3. Best Decorated**

- Gumbo must be homemade, (pre bought roux can be used but no takeout gumbo from your favorite Cajun restaurant!)
- 50% of the meat must be waterfowl (Duck/Goose)
- Gumbo can be made before the event or on-site
- Contestants must bring/make at minimum a 6-quart Crockpot worth of gumbo
- Contestant must reserve at least three 6 oz. cups for judges. Balance of gumbo to be sampled by attendees. (The greater the amount of sampling, the greater the chances of winning the people's choice!)

Each contestant's space measures 10' x 10' and includes 2 (two) chairs and 1 (one) 8' table. Contestants are allowed to bring own tent and are encouraged to decorate booths with team or club name as well as other hunting-related decorations. Contestant is responsible for providing sampling portion cups and plastic-ware, table coverings and appropriate signage.

Booth space will be available for set up/decoration from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm. Gates open to spectators at noon. Contestants should be ready to serve by 2 pm.

All trash, supplies, equipment, etc. must be removed from the facility no later than 10:30 pm the day of the event.
